Management Fellows Program

OVERVIEW

The Management Fellows Program offers a two-year paid fellowship for individuals aspiring towards careers in management within Los Angeles County's 38 departments. Inspired by the Federal Presidential Management Fellows Program, it aims to bolster County succession planning initiatives and cultivate future leaders. Participants engage in a diverse array of experiences, including dynamic service-oriented operations, County business functions, community-based initiatives, equity and inclusivity projects, capital programs, health and mental health services, and public safety.

DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING

Fellows are required to complete 160 hours of formal training, encompassing leadership courses, program or department-specific training, and attend workshops/seminars. Additionally, they benefit from exclusive networking opportunities and receive guidance and support from a mentor, aiding them in career development and personal/professional growth.

The County Management Fellows Program will start accepting applications in late May 2024. Notifications will be posted on the Department of Human Resources website and its Twitter and Instagram accounts.
